Created in Canada in 1994, the Jeunes Ambassadeurs Lyriques is an international program training and career development of singers from 18 to 35 years old.



Each spring, a national audition is organized in the cities of Montreal, Toronto and since this year, Victoria, to elect the winners of the program. In the fall, the selected singers will perform at the $Rencontres\ Lyriques$ $Internationales\ de\ Montréal$ and the $XXVI\ gala\ concert\ of\ the\ Jeunes\ Ambassadeurs\ Lyriques$. During these two stages, an international committee, bringing together world leaders, will select the most talented young singers to offer them opportunities around the world.
